All enrolled students at CEP schools are eligible to receive a healthy breakfast and lunch every day for **no charge** during the 2022-2023 school year. **No further action is required of you.** Your child(ren) will be able to participate in these meal programs without having to pay a fee or submit a meal application. Only breakfast and lunch meals will be free of charge; the purchase of a la carte items will require payment.
